**Experiential Education Contact Information**

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**Appropriate Sequence to Earn Privilege to attend Externship**

- 1) **L**ectures  
(Basic Pharmacy Calculations & Pharmacy Practice & Pharmacy Law)  
Final Exam – **70% to move on to externship**
- 2) **E**xternship  
Walgreens totaling 40 hours of externship hours with minimum grade of “**Satisfactory**” in the following three categories – *Customer Service, Team Work, Attitude*
- 3) **L**etter of Completion of Non-Credit Program if the student passes both Lectures & Externship

**Attendance Requirements**

Attendance is mandatory. Students should conduct themselves appropriately and abide by the company policies of the organization. Minimum hour requirements will be established by the Supervising Pharmacist and/or Lead Pharmacy Technician. Lawson State Community College will observe national holidays.

**Licensure and Registration**

Students must possess a valid and current Pharmacy Technician License. A copy should be given to the site coordinator so that it may be posted on the wall at the pharmacy practice site.

## **Assessment of Students**

Students should be assessed in the following categories:

- 3) Attitude

- 4) Remediation Needed

## **Site Specific Requirements**

**The following actions are strictly forbidden**

- 2) You may not report private (protected) academic information of another student or trainee. Such information might include, but is not limited to: course grades, narrative evaluations, examination scores, or adverse academic actions.
- 3) You may not represent yourself as another person.
- 4) You may not utilize websites and/or applications in a manner that interferes with your experiential learning while on or off the experiential site.
- 5) You may not knowingly distribute false evidence, statements or charges against another student, faculty, staff, affiliate clinical instructor, or experiential site of the School.
- 6) You may not use social media as a means of communicating inappropriate, uncivil or insulting comments or threats of violence regarding peer s, faculty, staff, affiliate clinical instructors, or experiential sites of the School.
- 7) You may not display use of language or photographs that imply disrespect for any individual or group. This is considered harassment and could have legal consequences.
