How would you counsel a patient’s parent needing Lovenox 300mg/3ml, directions for use, please give the patient 15mg q12h and dispense appropriate syringes. The patient’s weight is 33 pounds. How many vials (#mL’s) of medication would need to be dispensed? What are appropriate questions to ask the parent prior to dispensing the medication?

- 13) A physician calls to get dosing on Cefdinir for a patient with sinusitis. The child weighs 30 lbs, and is 15 months old. The physician states that the child has an allergy to Amoxicillin. Using Lexi-Comp what is the recommended mg/kg/day? What would be an appropriate dose in (milligrams) to recommend to the physician and for what duration (days)?
- 14) Use the information obtained from question 18 to answer question 19. Cefdinir comes in 125mg/5ml and 250mg/5ml; both concentrations come in 60ml and 100ml package sizes. Using both concentrations calculate the appropriate dose in (mL's). Which package size would you dispense if you used the 125mg/5ml? Which package size would you dispense if you used the 250mg/5ml?

15) Use the information obtained from question 18 and 19 to answer question 20. The mom comes to pickup the medication. Before mixing the medication you counsel. When counseling the mother you state, "I see your child has an allergy to amoxicillin. Can you describe the reaction your child had?"
